As we bid farewell to 2024 and step into a promising 2025, it is a fitting time to reflect on the key events of the past year, while looking ahead to the possibilities before us.

Throughout 2024, Christian Care welcomed 76 healthcare/rehab residents, 17 assisted living residents, and 14 independent living residents. We also said goodbye to 33 friends and residents, whose presence will be deeply missed. Our thoughts and prayers remain with their families.

We conducted CNA classes in 2024 and plan to offer three more in 2025, continuing our commitment to professional development and excellence in care.

Operationally, we made significant strides by implementing a new payroll system, Ahola, at the start of the year. This system has proven beneficial, providing excellent customer service to our Human Resources and Business Office staff. In June, we introduced a new accounting system, followed by the adoption of a new Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system in August. As we move into 2025, we will build on these improvements and fully integrate complementary modules to enhance organizational efficiency.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to Dr. Donley for her years of dedicated service to Christian Care. Her compassionate care and unwavering commitment have left a lasting impact, and we are immensely thankful for her contributions. We wish her all the best in her retirement.

We also warmly welcome Dr. Gresla, an Adams County Memorial Hospital physician, who brings extensive experience in long-term care medicine. We look forward to his positive contributions to our community in the coming year.

Nursing Notes

With the new year here and winter in full force, we are already looking forward to spring. An encouraging quote that I thought about is "No winter lasts forever; no spring skips its turn." This quote reminds us that change is constant, and new beginnings follow difficult times.

Healthcare is ever changing, and we all know that change is not always easy, but often necessary, and often a good thing.

We continue to offer frequent COVID vaccine clinics through the Wells County Health Department and have recently started to offer RSV clinics through the Health Department. The RSV vaccine is offered every two years. We have sent out consent forms, and several residents have already received the vaccine. If this is something you would like your loved one to have, even if you originally declined, please let us know.

RSV is a respiratory virus that can cause mild cold symptoms, to more severe symptoms such as pneumonia. Major risk factors include: being 75 years of age or older, having chronic heart and lung disease, having a weakened immune system, and living in a nursing home.

We love our residents, and want to do everything we can to keep them safe and be a blessing to them as much as they are a blessing to us. I think I can speak for all of us at Christian Care that it truly is an honor that we have been entrusted to care for our residents!


